Evaluating quality of commercial health plans

Since 2008, the Alliance has worked with the National Business Coalition on Health (NBCH) to conduct a rigorous evaluation of commercial health plans in Washington state using the eValue8[™] tool, and then publishing a report on the performance of commercial health plans in our market. Five of the six commercial health plans in our market participated in eValue8 this year: Aetna, Cigna, Group Health, Regence Blue Shield and UnitedHealthcare. Group Health participated separately as an HMO and as a PPO. In June, purchasers met with the health plans for a half day each to discuss the results as well as opportunities to align purchaser and health plan strategy to improve the value of health care in Washington. We will release a full report later this month.

Choosing Wisely Summit strengthens grantee network

In May, Alliance staff joined 70 other Choosing Wisely grantees in Washington, D.C. for a two-day summit on the Choosing Wisely campaign. Susie Dade (Alliance) and Jessica Martinson (Washington State Medical Association) spoke about collaborating with multiple organizations in order to support Choosing Wisely in our state.
