The Alliance will share the lessons learned from the [Driving Value Project](#), under the theme of ***Driving Purchaser Value Through APCD Insight***, at the National Association of Health Data Organizations (NAHDO) for its 36th Annual Conference, [Rising to the Challenge: Connecting Data with Policy](#). The Conference draws more than 400 attendees from across the country with the latest information from front-line experts on health data initiatives, innovations in analytics, and public reporting.

- the analysis of measures used to identify low- and high-value care from the [Community Checkup](#) and the Alliance's [First, Do No Harm](#) reports using the Milliman MedInsight Health Waste Calculator™,
- the levers for change, e.g., quality measurement, provider practice culture, payment and incentives, benefit design, and patient engagement, and
- the focus area of improving care delivery selected by Alliance purchasers and a significant and expensive health issue for many, low back pain.
