

Boulder Care Offers Innovative Telehealth Addiction Treatment in Partnership with Health Plans, Health Systems, and Employers

Over 40 million Americans struggle with a substance use disorder (SUD), and COVID-19 has only intensified the crisis: more than 100,000 Americans died from drug overdoses in the yearlong period ending in April 2021.

To address the growing need for accessible, affordable addiction treatment, [Boulder Care](#), a digital clinic that provides medical treatment and recovery services for SUD, is partnering with leading health plans, health systems, and employers—including many members of the Washington Health Alliance.

Boulder Care's specialized Care Team includes:

- **Clinicians**, who provide expert medical care and medication management;
- **Care Advocates**, who manage and coordinate care; and
- **Peer Specialists**, who share their own lived experience with recovery.

Patients access their dedicated Care Team through secure messaging, video visits, and 24/7 phone support. In addition to focusing on clinical outcomes, Boulder Care provides support for long-term health and wellness, as well as social determinants of health, like stable housing, employment, and financial security.

Boulder Care contracts with health plans and employers nationwide, typically through value-based payment arrangements that reward long-term care and quality outcomes. Boulder Care is currently working with all Washington Medicaid MCOs and most commercial health plans in Washington, as well as major health systems across the Pacific Northwest.
