Select Successes of the Collaborative

Universal agreement reached on a Pathway for high-value, evidence-based care with improved access.

Consensus on the importance of patient shared decision-making and supported self-management within the Care Pathway.

50% of Health Plans have reported changes to benefit offerings, including payment bundles and an Advanced Primary Care partnership.

Uniform message created for a patient-facing handout at a fifth grade reading level in six languages.

79% of Purchaser organizations have now modified, or plan to modify, benefit design.

38% of Provider organizations have made changes to their EMR systems to address equity concerns.

89% of Provider organizations have implemented elements of the Care Pathway into clinical settings.

50% of Purchaser organizations are now working with health plans to analyze data for equity and/or quality.

Many shared innovative approaches to addressing equity care gaps.

31% of Stakeholders have implemented, or plan to implement, new improvements specific to equity.

29% of Purchaser organizations have created new member education tools specific to acute low back pain.

80% of participants reported plans to take learnings back to their organizations to implement change.
